#### WHY CHURCH PLANT IN FARGO?

Fargo is a rapidly growing city with a population of about 238,000 in the metropolitan area. It is the largest city in North Dakota and is very much a university town. Together with its "twin city" Moorhead, it has three major colleges. Fargo is home to North Dakota State University, which is the largest of these colleges enrolling around 13,000 students. Fargo is a cultural and economic hub in North Dakota. This means it is a strategic place to plant when thinking about reaching the whole state. Lord willing, we hope that Christ Covenant Church will be a church plant that plants other churches in this region.

### **BUT IT'S SO COLD...**

North Dakota is a difficult place to move to if you have no connections to the area. This is one of the reasons that a primarily southern denomination such as the PCA has no churches in the whole state! For most people entering the ministry, North Dakota is low on the list of desirable locations. Both the location and the weather can make it a difficult place to live. With that said, both Brock and Katie call North Dakota home—Fargo is where Brock was raised and Katie has lived for 10+ years. This is part of the reason they have a heart for Fargo, and feel the Lord is calling them to ministry in this part of the country.
